Sub: Fresh Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary and Senior Secondary School Examination to the above said school.

Sir/Madam,

In supersession to this office letter dated 12.05.2010, I am directed to convey the sanction for Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary and Senior Secondary School Examination (under switch over category) of the Board to the above said school for a period of **three years** w.e.f. 1/4/2010 to 31/3/2013.

1. Languages:- English Elective/Core, Hindi Elective/Core
2. Elective:- Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Education.

The above sanction is subject to fulfilment of following conditions:-

1. "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
2. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary and Senior Secondary School Examinations and changes made therein from time to time.
3. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII: -

Campus Area	Enrollment	No. of Sections (Pre-primary to X)	No. of Sections at Sr. Secondary (XI & XII)
(a) 1.0 acre	1250	02 in each class	04 in each class XI and XII
(b) 1.5 acre	1875	03 in each class	04 in each class XI and XII
(c) 2.0 acre	2500	04 in each class	04 in each class XI and XII
(d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.			
4. The School will not sponsor candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch, which is not affiliated.
5. The school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Board's class X/XII Examinations from the year mentioned above without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates. Failure to do so will lead to *suo moto* withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for secondary Examination granted by the Board.
6. The school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
7. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
